

## Clarivein and Foam Sclerotherapy right leg

### Concern

Visible varicose veins to right leg that were causing symptoms

### Consultation

Assessment and duplex ultrasound which confirmed that the visible veins were being fed by an incompetent main vein in the thigh.

### Treatment

During the same appointment, the incompetent main thigh vein was treated with a Clarivein catheter and the visible veins were injected with foam. No anaesthesia was required. The procedure took around 30 minutes and the patient was able to resume normal activities straightaway
